12-1 p.m.	Arrival/Check in at the shelter
1-4:30 p.m.	*Program time with your tribe
4 p.m.	Chiefs Meeting (at the Y Guides Store)
4:30 p.m.	Begin packing up (need to finish before meeting for the Ceremony)
5: 30 p.m.	All Second Years meet at the Dining Hall with your lantern
5: 45 p.m.	All First Years gather in the road across from the Y Guides Store
6 p.m.	Processional to the Ceremony* <i>Please note we must wait for the sun to set in order provide the best ceremony experience. This time could vary.</i>
7 p.m.	Head home

*During your program time your tribe can cookout, play games, or go on a hike (Trailhead by the Office). BBs, Archery & Canoeing (weather/water dependent) will be open until 4:30 p.m.

All **Second Year** participants that brought lanterns need to report to the Dining Hall by 5:30 p.m. You will receive directions at this time. **Be sure to bring your lantern home**
