4:30 p.m.	Captains Meeting (at the Y Guides Store)
4:45 p.m.	Begin packing up (need to finish before meeting for the Ceremony)
5:15 p.m.	All Second-Years meet near the Gym with your lantern
5:30 p.m.	All First-Years gather in the field across from the Y Guides Store
5:45 p.m.	Processional to the Ceremony* <i>Please note we must wait for the sun to set in order to provide the best ceremony experience. This time could vary.</i>
7 p.m.	Head home

*During your program time your Crew can cookout, play games, or go on a hike (Trailhead by Archery). BBs, Archery, the Y Guides Store, Gnome Hunting, the Rock Throwing Arena & Canoeing will be open until 4:30 p.m.

All **Second-Year** participants should report to the outdoor gym by 5:15 p.m. with their lanterns to participate in the second-year Bear Claw exchange. You will receive directions for the Lantern Ceremony during this time. **Be sure to bring your lantern home after the ceremony!**

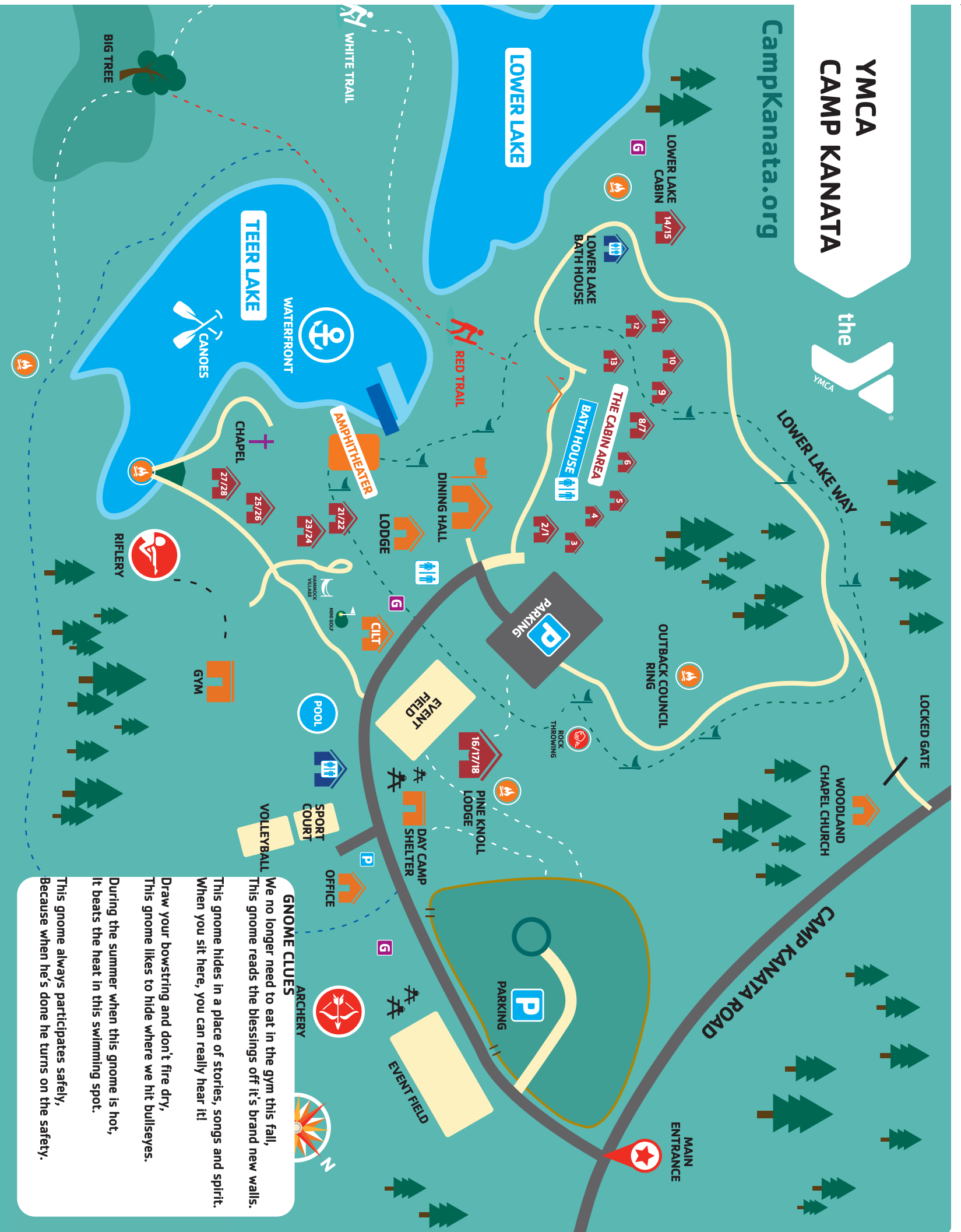
